

How To Clean Your Soapstone

The number one rule would be not to use anything abrasive that could scratch the stone or remove the polished finish.

The best may be a mild detergent (like Dawn) dissolved in some water and rubbed on the stone with a soft cloth. Even a spray like Windex can be used.

Sometimes, something gets burned or melted on the stone and seems like it has been absorbed into the stone. For these stains, you can use a small propane torch. Just move the top of the flame slowly back and forth over the stain until it is gone. It will incinerate the stain without damaging the stone. *This will require some ventilation.
