Who We Are

Operation BBQ Relief is a 501c3, not-for-profit corporation founded in May, 2011 in response to a need for relief efforts in tornado-stricken Joplin, Missouri. In the wake of this nearly unprecedented destruction, competition barbecue teams from eight states answered the call to help feed displaced families and police, fire, National Guard and emergency personnel. The group was able to serve over 120,000 barbecue meals in less than two weeks.



As a result of efforts in Joplin, Operation BBQ Relief was born. The Joplin operation was used as a model for subsequent disasters such as hurricanes, wildfires, earthquakes, floods and other tornadoes. We are ready to respond to natural disaster emergencies across the United States. In the months since Joplin, OBR has served a total of 311,900 hot meals in 14 states during twelve disasters.
